



Exquisite Eurasier's Application for Eurasier Ownership

Thank you for your interest in Exquisite Eurasiers. We would appreciate it if you take some time to complete this application. Our commitment is to find homes for our Eurasiers where they will be treated as permanent **family** members. That is what the temperament of the breed requires, and that is the tradition of Eurasier ownership. We breed only healthy dogs. Your responses will assist us in selecting the puppy that has the best personality for your family. **We select your puppy** for you based upon matching the puppy's traits with your family's lifestyle. *Gender and color are secondary considerations.* Please answer all questions honestly, if

you are not sure, ask. Phone conversations are welcomed and phone interviews are mandatory. **All** questions **MUST** be answered in full before your application will be considered. A puppy is \$5,500 plus state and local sales tax {as of October 2023 subject to change without notice}, a \$1,000 Nonrefundable fee will secure your price and place on our waiting list. An additional \$1,000 payment is required upon a confirmed pregnancy and puppy count or deferral request. A total of \$3,500, including previous fees/payments, is due upon the assignment of a specific puppy. Fees and payments are non-refundable if you change your mind. The earliest received applications and payments receive first consideration. Full payment of the balance is due before the adoption takes place. Personal checks are acceptable if received at least 20 business days before picking up your new companion, otherwise, we require cash or bank check.

VETERINARY CARE:

Our puppies receive their first vaccinations at 6-7 weeks of age. Those vaccinations include Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parvovirus, and Parainfluenza. Depending upon your local conditions your reputable vet may recommend additional vaccinations and we urge you to consider their professional advice. As a condition of sale, you agree to follow all state and local laws regarding any additional vaccinations as required. Do you agree?

It is recommended that exams for hip/elbow dysplasia, patella luxation, thyroid, and eye normalcy be given when the Eurasier reaches 2 years of age. Do you plan to proceed with this testing and certification?

Puppies cost \$5,500 plus state and local sales tax {as of October 2023 subject to change without notice}. This includes the first set of shots, micro-chip, vet health check, and deworming. They go home with a scent / security blanket from the whelping box, informational booklet, harness, leash, toys, engraved name tag, and various “goodies.” Photos can and will be emailed to adopters once a week or more. We ask that the new puppy parents keep in contact with us either by email or text and or phone several times throughout each year. The puppy’s health and wellbeing are of utmost importance to us and we reserve the right to refuse a sale at our discretion for any reason. Puppies will be registered to only one person. This application becomes a part of the sales agreement.
